

4 YEARS OF DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE GOVERNMENT OF PUNJAB

1. FREE EMERGENCY MEDICAL RESPONSE SERVICES

- Procurement of 240 Ambulances at the cost of Rs. 77 Crores to provide the Emergency Medical Response Services during Medical Emergencies.
- These Ambulances to reach at the emergency site within 25 minutes by dialing Number 108 from anywhere in the State.
- 90 ambulances already launched and the remaining 150 ambulances shall be rolled in phases by August 2011.

2. Rs. 346 CRORES CORE PLAN FOR HEALTH INFRASTRUCTURE

- Establishment of 1 new District Hospital at Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar (Nawanshahar) and up-gradation of 2 District Hospitals Muktsar and Tarn Taran at a cost of Rs. 35 Crores.
- Construction of 5 new Sub Divisional Hospitals at Khadoor Sahib, Moonak, Tappa, Bholath, Ghudda and up-gradation of 3 SDHs Dera Bassi, Budhlada and Baba Bakala started at a cost of Rs. 55 Crores.
- Work has been started for construction of 32 new 30 bedded Community Health Centers (CHCs) at a cost of Rs. 150 Crores.
- 3 Community Health Centers at Morinda, Adampur and Zirakpur already made functional.
- Repair and Renovation work in 450 PHCs has been taken up at a cost of Rs. 70 Crores.
- All Hospitals shall be provided requisite staff & equipments by August 2011.

3. RECRUITMENTS

- 126 Specialist Doctors, 526 Medical Officers (General), 34 Medical Officers (Dental) and 37 Drug Inspectors have already been recruited.
- 1296 Staff Nurses, 1692 ANMs, 300 Para Medical Staff and 700 other employees have been recruited in the department to provide better health care services.
- Govt. will ensure that all hospitals are provided with requisite doctors, other manpower and equipments by 2011.

4. MATERNAL & CHILD HEALTH CARE SERVICES

- Free delivery in all Govt. Hospitals since December 2008.
- Rs. 200/- as transportation cost to every Pregnant Woman for coming to hospital for delivery.
- Incentives of up-to Rs. 700/- to every BPL/SC woman under Janani Suraksha Yojna (JSY).
- Number of Institutional deliveries have increased by 3 times from 44,450 in year 2007 to 1,20,000 during the year 2010-11.
- Reduction in Infant Mortality Rate by 6 points from 44 in 2006 to 38 in year 2009.

5. IMPROVEMENT IN SEX-RATIO

- A Jump in Sex-Ratio by 43 points from 798 in year 2001 to 846 in year 2011.
- Cash Award of Rs. 50,000/- to informers for providing information regarding an Ultrasound Center indulging in sex determination of foetus.
- Award of Rs.1.5 lacs each to 158 Panchayats for improvement in Sex-Ratio in their villages.

6. SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAMME

- Free treatment to all students of Govt. & Govt. Aided Schools for Heart ailments (RHD/CHD), Cancer & Thallesemia in PGI, Chandigarh and other Super Specialty Hospitals.
- 1065 students already treated at a cost of Rs. 9.5 Crores.
- Health Cards & Annual Health Checkups of all 30 lacs students studying in 19686 Govt. schools.

7. OTHER MAJOR SERVICES

- Dialysis Machines in all 20 District Hospitals.
- Blood Component Separators in all 20 District Hospitals and Aphaeresis machines in 6 District hospitals for treatment of dengue patients.
- Phaco machines for eye operations and Auto-Analyzers in all 20 District Hospitals.
- 81 new Dental Chairs.
- 50 new Ambulances.

8. MOBILE MEDICAL UNITS (MMU)

- 24 MMUs in all the 20 districts for providing medical services to the door steps of the people.
- 2 doctors, 3 para-medics and other equipments including Laboratory, X-Ray and ECG machines in the MMUs.
- Free medicines up-to Rs. 10,000/- per month in every MMU.
- 8 MMU's by M/s Ranbaxy Healthcare for the districts of Mansa, Bathinda and Muktsar Sahib.

9. MULTI-SPECIALTY HOSPITALS

- 2 Multi-specialty Hospitals at Bathinda & SAS Nagar (Mohali) in Public Private Partnership mode at a cost of Rs. 200 Crores.
- These 200 bedded hospitals to provide specialty services to the patients suffering from various ailments including Cancer.

10. CAMPAIGN AGAINST ADULTERATION AND HABIT FORMING DRUGS

- Special campaign launched to check adulteration in food items.
- 18514 samples collected during the last 4 years and legal action taken against 2796 persons.
- Habit forming drugs worth Rs. 12.50 Crores seized; 8196 samples taken and action pursued against 421 defaulters.
- A Drug De-addiction Center at Talwandi Sabo made functional at a cost of Rs. 2 Crores.
- Drug De-addiction Centers set-up in 7 District Hospitals and work started in the remaining 13 districts at a cost of Rs. 5 Crores.
- Rules notified for regulation of all Private De-addiction Centers in the State.

11. OTHER IMPORTANT WORKS

- 3 Trauma Centers already established at Amritsar, Jalandhar & Pathankot and work at Khanna in progress at a cost of Rs. 16 Crores.
- GNM Nursing School started in Civil Hospital, Jalandhar in August 2010.
- Jan Aushadhi Stores (JAS) opened in all District Hospitals to provide medicines at cheaper rates.

12. AYUSH

- Recruitment of 211 Ayurvedic Medical Officers, 112 Homeopathic Doctors and 335 Para-medical staff.
- Work for construction of 5 new Ayurvedic hospitals started.
- 4 Arogya maha-melas organized at Amritsar, Ludhiana, Bhatinda & Amritsar.
- 10 bedded Panch-karma Center has been started at Mohali

13. NATIONAL LEVEL AWARDS

- Punjab rated at Number 1 in the country under complete Immunization Programme.
- Punjab rated at Number 2 position in Non scalpel Vasectomy Programme.
- Punjab among 2 States to get National Award under AIDS Control Programme.
