

ENTOMOLOGIST AT STATE HQS

The Entomologist will report to State Surveillance Officer (SSO) IDSP.

Objective of the assignment

The main objectives of the assignment are to:

- a) Provide technical support to State/ District RRTs in Vector related issues.
- b) Undertake Entomological Surveillance, map and monitor Entomological Density and Bionomics and Sensitivity for Insecticides.
- c) Undertake entomological investigations including susceptibility tests, fauna studies etc.
- d) Support the preparation and implementation of integrated vector management plans
- e) Undertake regular field visits as per the schedule of NVBDCP to monitor and evaluate the timeliness and quality of vector control measures such as Indoor Residual Spray, insecticide treated nets and distribution of larvivorous fish.
- f) Liaise with block medical officers and malaria inspectors to ensure timely implementation of vector control operations
- g) Support preparation, implementation and monitoring of district action plan for control of vector borne diseases
- h) Organize locally relevant behavior change communication initiatives to improve household behaviors towards vector borne diseases control.

M. Sc. (Zoology) with entomology as one of the subjects

Experience:

Minimum 1 year experience in Vector Borne Disease Control.

45 years or below (in exceptional cases age upto 60 years may be considered)
