**\*\*\*Driving test will be conducted for the post mentioned at S.No. 12 and only those candidates will be considered, who will qualify the driving test.**

**\*\*\*\* The classifications for the total no. of posts be read as :- General, Scheduled Casts, Backward Classes, Handicapped, Ex- Servicemen, Sports Persons and Freedom Fighters.**

**Terms and conditions:**

- All posts will be on contractual basis initially for 1 year to be renewed on the basis of work, conduct and performance every year.
- Educational qualification must be from a recognized University/ Board as per details mentioned against each post
- Age Limit: Between 18 and 37 years as on **1<sup>st</sup> Jan. 2011. (01.01.2011). Age relaxation as per the rules of Punjab Government.**
- **Relaxation in upper age for SC/BC, candidates is 5 years and for Physically Handicapped is 10 years and for candidates of Ex- Servicemen category, the age relaxation will be as follows:-**  
" For recruitment to any vacancy in the State Civil Services whether reserved or not under these rule an Ex-Servicemen shall be allowed to deduct the period of his service in the Armed Forces of the Union from his actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for direct appointment to such vacancy in the concerned Service rules, by more than 3 years, he shall be deemed to satisfy the condition regarding age limit."  
• Only those candidates who have passed Punjabi subject in Matriculation or above are eligible to apply.
- **Reservation will be as per applicable rules & Punjab Govt. policy guidelines.**
- The SC/ BC Category certificate should be in accordance with the instructions of the department of welfare Punjab and the certificate for the Ex-Serviceman, Freedom fighters and Sports persons categories should be in accordance with instruction of the Concerned Department as per the followings details:-

Ex-Servicemen	Lineal Descendant certificate duly issued by the concerned Distt. Ex-Serviceman Welfare Officer.

Sports persons	The certificate regarding gradation issued by the Director, Sports Department, Punjab.

Note:-

Candidates applying under the above mentioned 4 categories, should have mentioned certificates before last date of filing the applications.

- Reservation shall be as per the policy/instructions of the Punjab Government. It shall include candidates of:- SC, BC, EX-Servicemen, Handicapped persons, freedom fighter & Sportspersons, Categories The qualification of candidates should be prior to the last date of filing the applications.
- No TA, DA will be paid for the journeys performed for the written test/ counseling.
- **The candidate applying for more than one post / category shall have to apply separately, along with necessary fees.**

**How to apply online**

1. Before applying online non-refundable Bank Demand Draft for Rs 450/- (Rs 250/- for SC Candidates) in favour of "Director, C-DAC, Mohali **payable at Mohali/ Chandigarh** should be ready as the application fee details are needs to be entered in the form.
2. Fill the online application form available on the website <http://recruitment.cdacmohali.in> by clicking at the link **Recruitment of Various D.H.S. Posts.**

3. The application can be filled online only till 18-03-2011 **up to 5.00 PM**.
4. If by mistake the candidate has filed in wrong data, he/she can correct the data from 4-3-2011 **to 18-03-2011 up to 5:00 PM**. by entering his/her registration number and password. Henceforth no editing will be done and thereafter data will be locked and no change will be acceptable/ allowed.
5. The Registration slip will be generated after filing the online form. Get the printout (2 copies) of the registration slip.
6. Only online forms will be entertained. The registration number generated in the form should be written at the back of the demand draft along with the name of the candidate, father name and postal address.
7. Send/ post one copy of the on line registration slip (Printed) with a self attested photograph along with the original demand draft of requisite fee (Non refundable) to **"Director, C-DAC, A-34,Phase 8, industrial area Mohali** which should reach positively by 25-3-2011 (Please do not send any other document). The application fee in the shape of demand draft received after the last date i.e. 25-3-2011 will not be considered.

The candidate can download their **ADMIT CARDS** by visiting the website <http://recruitment.cdacmohali.in> again by entering his/her registration number and password (**Candidates are advised not to disclose the password to any one for data security**) from 12-04-2011. Incase candidate unable to get the admit card, he/ she must contact C-DAC Mohali personally or on helpline numbers one day before the said examination **upto 5.00 PM**, failing which department will not be held responsible.

12. Candidate must bring a admit card/ Registration slip on the day of written examination at the venue of the examination centre. The candidates without admit card/ Registration slip will not be allowed to appear in the written examination.
13. Candidate will be responsible for any mistakes made by him/ her in the on line application form, Health Department shall not be responsible or liable in any way.
14. The merit list will be prepared on the basis of the written test and will be available on [www.pbhealth.gov.in](http://www.pbhealth.gov.in), <http://pbnrh.org> and website <http://recruitment.cdacmohali.in>
15. The venue date and time of counselling will be available on the website [www.pbhealth.gov.in](http://www.pbhealth.gov.in), and <http://pbnrh.org> Candidates will not be informed individually about the result and counseling schedule.

**Instructions:**

1. The candidate has to apply only online <http://recruitment.cdacmohali.in>. No other mode of applying will be entertained.
2. The written examination will be conducted out of those candidates only who will fulfill the prescribed academic and technical qualification and will submit the bank demand draft of prescribed fee.
3. The recruitment will be made based on the **merit of the WRITTEN TEST ONLY** except the posts of drivers, specifically for each category of post however in case driver posts the recruitment will be don on the basis of the written test and driving test.
4. The proposed date for the written examination for the said posts are : 16-4-2011 , 17-4-2011, 23-4-2011, 24-4-2011, 30-4-2011 & 1-5-2011. The venue of exam centre will be available on the website on 12-4-2011.

5. The candidates should reach the examination centre one hour before the start of the examination. At the examination centre, the candidate has to produce his/her admit card pasted with passport size photograph and duly attested by self along with identity proof, which may be either any of from the Driving license, Voter ID Card, Passport, PAN Card.
6. The candidate has to verify himself that he/she fulfils all the eligibility conditions for this post. Appearing in the examination and qualifying the test does not entitle him/her for appointment to the post. The selection will be subject to his/her found eligible for the post. Verification of original documents would be done at the time of counseling. The purpose would be to verify different records regarding identification, age, qualifying examination, state of eligibility, category etc, of the candidate. On failing to establish of any of the documents the candidate will not be considered for recruitment and liable for criminal action.
7. The Question Paper will be of objective type (100 marks) having 100 questions with multiple choices on OMR sheet with one correct answer of each question of appropriate standards. The duration of the paper will be of 90 minutes. There will be NO NEGATIVE MARKING. Each right answer will carry one mark.
8. No candidate will be allowed to appear in the examination without Roll Number Slip and identity proof in original.
9. Candidates should bring with them BLUE or BLACK Ball Pens only. Books, written notes, calculator, mobile phones and other electronic devices etc. will not be permitted to be carried in the examination hall.
