B. TERM OF MEMBERS

Term of official members will be till the time they hold the office by virtue of which they are members. Term of non-official members will be for maximum three years, to be re-nominated or nominated afresh at the end of three years or earlier as decided by the Mission.

C. FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS

The District Health Mission will meet at least once in a quarter.

D. ORDINARY BUSINESS

These functions under the District Health Mission would be carried out by the District Health Society :-

- Identification of policy changes to be taken up with the State Health Mission
- Consideration and approval of plans/ proposals for submission to the State Health Mission
- Consideration and approval of proposals within the delegated powers
- Review of progress in implementation of NRHM.
- Advocacy measures required to promote NRHM visibility
- Providing health system oversight in the district.
- Implementing various health schemes/ policies in the district as envisaged by the State Health Mission.
- Implementation of various National and State Health Programmes in the district.
- Ensuring Inter-sectoral convergence and integrated planning.
