**Subject: - Release of Annual Maintenance Grant for Community Health Centres, Primary Health Centres and under NRHM for the year 2008-09**

Please refer to the subject cited above.

2. Government of India Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi has approved Annual Maintenance Grant for the year 2008-09 under NRHM for Community Health Centres (CHCs), Primary Health Centres (PHCs) and Sub Centres (SCs) @ Rs. 1.00 Lakh Rs. 0.50 lakh and Rs. 00.10 Lakh respectively for the State of Punjab under NRHM.


3. These grants are to be utilized strictly according to guidelines provided by Govt. of India (copies enclosed). At present, Punjab State has 20 districts with 2858 Sub Centres, 484 PHCs and 128 CHCs functioning therein. Accordingly, the allocation of funds to all the districts has been made as under:-

It is further added that since PHC level Rogi Kalyan Samitis are not in position, a PHC Management Committee headed by Senior Medical Officer / Medical Officer Incharge PHC/ Mini PHC has been constituted with the approval of Hon'ble Health Minister as conveyed to all the Civil Surgeons and Govt. of India vide this office letter No. NRHM (M&E)/Pb/2007/1513-31 dated 5.4.2007. These funds at the level of:-

- i) Sub Centre are to be kept in the joint Block Account in the name of ANM and Sarpanch
- ii) Primary Health Centre are to be kept in a separate Joint Bank Account in the name of PHC Management Committee and will be operated jointly by the Senior Medical Officer / Medical Officer Incharge PHC/ Mini PHC and Sarpanch of the village where PHC is situated.
- iii) Community Health Centre are to be kept in the Bank account of the Rogi Kalyan Samiti (RKS)/ Hospital Management Committee


